- 4. Follow Step-1, Fill up details of personal information.
- 5. Follow Step-2, and Step-3 to entry, the details of last examination passed and Upload your scanned photograph, signature, Marksheet of 10+2 Standard and Caste/category certificate if any. Follow Step-4 fill up the subjects for which you want to apply. N.B: Please recheck and accept terms and conditions and then submit.
- 6. Make payment through online mode
- 7. Submit the form in online mode finally. No editis allowed after final submission.
- 8. Take print out of submitted form, paste photograph, signed in appropriate places and keep it with you till physical verification by the college after admission.

Documents to be brought along with the printed Form during verification after admission:

- Original and Self attested Photocopy of Admit card of Madhyamik/Proof of age.
- Original and Self attested Photocopy of Marksheet of qualifying Exam (10+2) level.
- 3. Original and Self attested Photocopy of Registration certificate of qualifying examination (10+2) level.
- 4. Original and Self attested Photocopy of caste/PWD certificate where applicable.
- 5. Original and Self attested registration certificate of earlier passed out candidate if registered to any University

Admission Regulations

1. 4-Year Bachelor's degree (Honours/Honours with Research) with Major in Arts subjects:

 (a) A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examination is eligible to seek admission to the 1st year of the B.A. (Single-Major) Course of Studies provided the candidate has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100.

However, no student shall be allowed to take admission after a lapse of more than 3 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. (Explanation: The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating three years from the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination). 1. (b) Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or its equivalent from the All India Boards/Councils (i.e. CBSE, ISC and National Institute of Open Schooling) need not require to submit the Migration Certificate for getting Registration under this University.

2. For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the B.A (Single-Major) Courses, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in topfour subjects in order of marks secured by a student. However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However, if the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

(a) A student taking up Major Course in a subject must have obtained:

i. A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

Or

ii. 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

Or

iii. 50% marks in the aggregate when the student has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.

(b) Students belonging to Reserved Categories taking up Major Course of Study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% marks in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be.

2. 3-year Bachelor's degree with Multidisciplinary Programme of studies in Humanities:

Admission Regulations

1. (a) A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examination is eligible to seek admission to the 1st year of the B.A. (Multidisciplinary) Course of Studies provided the student has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100.

Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational examination conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.A. (Multidisciplinary) 1st year Course of Studies taking the subjects under Humanities Discipline only.

However, no student shall be allowed admission after a lapse of more than 3 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. (Explanation: The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating three years from the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination).

(b) Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or its equivalent from the All India Boards/Councils (i.e. CBSE, ISC and National Institute of Open Schooling) need not require to submit the Migration Certificate for getting Registration under this University.

2. For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the B.A. (Multidisciplinary) Courses, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of marks secured by a student. However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However, if the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

N.B: It is also mentioned that the admission is provisional unless or until the candidate is registered to calcutta University through this college. Any suppression of facts or wrong production of facts, found in future, will cancel the admission.
